

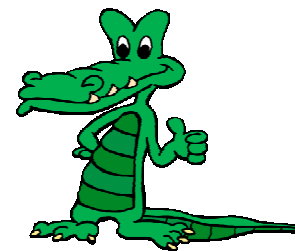

Sue Holeman - Literacy Council Gulf Coast

Susan was named President and CEO of the Literacy Council Gulf Coast in January 2012. Originally she led the Literacy Council starting in June 2006. In 2011, Susan presided over the merger of Literacy Volunteers of Lee County with the Literacy Council of Bonita Springs, bringing together two long-time literacy organizations focused on adult and family literacy. She has overseen tremendous growth in numbers of students served, from 1,549 students to over 4,000 students throughout Lee, Hendry and Collier Counties. The Carol DeJoy Moms and Tots® Family Literacy Program has grown from two locations to 11 locations throughout the county serving over 1,800 moms and pre-school children. Under her leadership, the Literacy Council Gulf Coast has been recognized as the largest non-profit and non-governmental literacy organization in the US.

Susan has over 20 years of experience in non-profit management, fundraising and community relations. Additional experience includes training/teaching and development and advocacy. She has a Master's degree in Social Work with a concentration in Planning and Management from Indiana University.

She attributes her lifelong interest in language education to her father, who, though born in the U.S., grew up in the former Czechoslovakia and returned to the United States at age 16. While growing up in NW Indiana, she saw the difficulty he encountered in speaking and writing English and is dedicated to helping others improve their quality of life by improving their English skills.

In 2013, Susan received the Distinguished Alumna Award from the Indiana University School of Social Work in recognition of outstanding abilities, accomplishments and contributions to the profession of social work. In 2014, she was presented with the Ethics in Leadership Award from the Rotary Club of Bonita Springs.

Susan has two children: Jessica Merritt, who is pursuing a Ph.D. in Religious Studies at Indiana University and Jordan Merritt, who is finishing Ph.D. studies in Biomedical Sciences at Florida Atlantic University.
