

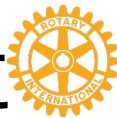

David is currently the Chief of Safety, Security, Emergency Management, and Fleet Operations with the School District of Lee County. He retired from the Cape Coral Police Department as Police Chief with 30 years of law enforcement experience, having spent his entire career with the Cape Coral Police Department.

David has experience in various aspects of public safety. During his career, he has been assigned to the Patrol Bureau, Investigative Services Bureau, where he worked in VICE (including participation in task forces), such as DEA, major crimes, and property crimes, and the Professional Standards Bureau, where he was responsible for Personnel and Training, Internal Affairs, Budget, policy writing, and accreditation.

David holds a Bachelor's degree in Public Administration from Barry University and a Master's degree with a major in Human Resources Development and Administration from Barry University. He is a graduate of the 252nd session of the FBI National Academy. He is also a graduate of the Administrative Officers Management Program at North Carolina State University, a graduate of the Florida Criminal Justice Executive Institute's Executive Leadership Seminar, and a graduate of the 58th session of the Police Executive Research Forum Senior Management Institute for Police.

David is also a Certified Assessor (Team Leader) for the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA), and the past President for the Southwest Florida Police Chiefs' Association, and a member of several organizations: Safety Committee for the Boys and Girls Club, board member for FUSE, a Human trafficking Awareness Foundation, FPCA, IACP, and FBINAA. David is a Florida native and has lived in Lee County, Florida, since 1977.

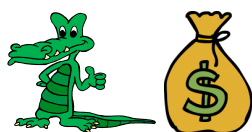

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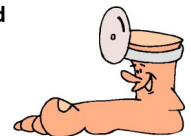
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
