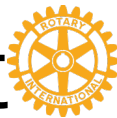

Colonel Rodney Scott Robinson was born in Live Oak, Florida in 1964. His dad was in Air Force so Col Robinson grew up as an Air Force Brat and lived in Georgia, Florida, Germany, Texas, and Utah.

COL Robinson's military career started as an airman in the Air Force Reserves. He served there for three years as an aircraft mechanic as he attended Weber State College in Ogden Utah. As a college sophomore, Col Robinson transferred from the Air Force Reserves to the 163rd Armor Cavalry Troop (Attack Helicopter), Utah Army National Guard under the ROTC Simultaneous Membership Program and joined Army ROTC at Weber State.

Upon college graduation, Second Lieutenant Robinson attended Army Flight School at Fort Novosel Alabama. On his return to Utah, he served full time as a National Guard Aviation Officer. In 2004 Lt Col Robinson, deployed to Afghanistan as Commander of Task Force Pirate, for Operation Enduring Freedom 5.

Col Robinson also served in most officer positions of the 1st Battalion 211th Aviation and 211th Aviation Group and commanded the 97th Aviation Troop Command. In 2011 he retired while serving as the Director of Aviation and Safety for the Utah Army National Guard.

After military retirement, he served as the Senior Army Instructor at Fort Myers High School JROTC from July 2012 to March 2022. Next, COL Robinson served as the Assistant Director of JROTC and now as Director of Army Instruction for the School District of Lee County where he serves all 6,500 Lee County JROTC Cadets.

Col Robinson is married to Joanne Moran. They have four grown children Cory, Jessica, Wade, Hunter and have six grandchildren.

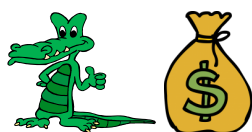

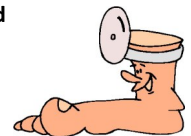
